

Name That Plane: January by Tim Roliff



The November aircraft was the Supermarine Stranraer. The Stranraer was a 1930s flying boat designed and built by the British Supermarine Aviation Works company principally for the Royal Air Force. They entered operations in 1937 and many were in service at the outbreak of the Second World War undertaking anti-submarine and convoy escort patrols.

They were withdrawn from operational service in March 1941 but continued to serve in a training capacity until October 1942. Thanks to Ken Pressman for supplying the picture, taken at the Royal Air Force Museum in London, England. Correct answers were submitted by Ed Malec, Todd Davis and Chris Milbauer.


